

What makes a Fairtrade Town?

Horsham has officially been a Fairtrade Town since 2005. We have achieved this by reaching the targets below and to maintain our Fairtrade status we must continue to improve on them.

- The local council must pass a resolution supporting Fairtrade, and serve Fairtrade coffee and tea at its meetings and in offices and canteens.
- A range of Fairtrade products must be readily available in the area's shops and served in local cafés and catering establishments
- Fairtrade products must be used by a number of local work places and community organisations (churches, schools etc)
- Attract media coverage and popular support for the campaign
- A local Fairtrade steering group must be convened to ensure continued commitment to Fairtrade Town status.

Could you help our campaign?

Buying Fairtrade makes a real difference to the lives of producers in the developing world who do not usually get a fair price for their goods in the world market. When you buy Fairtrade it ensures they get a reasonable price plus a social premium which is invested in their community.

What Fairtrade products can I buy in Horsham?

The range is constantly growing and includes: Coffee, tea, sugar, hot chocolate, cocoa, bananas, oranges, apples, pears, avocados, lemons, mangoes, pineapples, wine, fruit juice, nuts, spices, biscuits, cereal bars, snacks, cakes, rice, quinoa, sauces, olive oil, wine, beer, flowers, honey, syrup, jam, ice cream, muesli, baby food, T shirts, jeans, cotton wool, cosmetics, chocolate spread, desserts, chocolate, gifts, cards....

Where can I buy them?

Some shops stock a lot of products such as: Co op, Marks and Spencers. Sainsburys, Tesco's, Waitrose,

If your usual shops do not stock Fairtrade please ask them to change their practice and so ensure that producers in the developing world receive a fair price for their goods.
